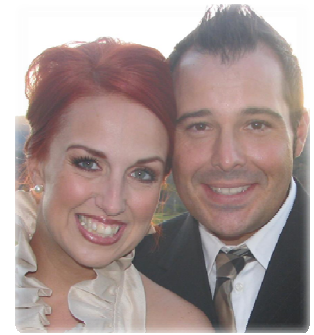

Do we understand the times we are living? In 1 Chronicles 12:32 it states, “And the children of Issachar who were men who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do...” There have been many changes over the years in the ministry of Children’s Bible Ministries. Some have probably caught this ministry by surprise. Surely those who ministered back in the 1950’s could not have imagined the time when you were not allowed to teach the Bible in schools. Yet in spite of the changes, CBM has met the challenges of the times in which we now live. Since last September through the end of August of 2013 there have been over 1300 decisions to trust Jesus Christ as one’s personal Savior. How thankful we are that this ministry is still seeing responses to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They have also seen many young people disciplined in the Word of God by the over 20,000 correspondence lessons per year being completed. We should be so thankful for the time we are living and the window of opportunity God has given to us to reach this generation for Christ.

We now approach the year 2014 and CBM has a new National Director, Lincoln Simmons, along with his wife, Jamie, who will assume the role of the Director of Ministry Development.

Again we see this as understanding the times we live in and recognizing that CBM needed a special couple to lead this ministry through the open doors God has provided. I am reminded what the apostle Paul said to the church at Colossae: “praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the Word...” Col. 4:3. Paul continued by saying that the purpose was that he would be able to speak forth the Gospel and that he would make it clear! There are so many voices calling out to the children of this age. We need a leader that knows the time is short and that the only thing that is able to save their soul is the Gospel!

Who are these new leaders in the Ministry of CBM?

Lincoln is a graduate of Pensacola Christian College in 1999. Lincoln has owned his own business for 10 years and has been a manager in other businesses. He has been involved in CBM for many years, first as a camper, then as a counselor, TEAM Leader, Board member, and Program Manager. Presently Lincoln is the Business Director, Operations Manager, and Outreach Director which includes the Bible Correspondence program and the After-School Bible Clubs at our CBM camp in Polk City, FL, Camp Gilead. Obviously, his experience has prepared him well to assume the role of National Director of CBM.

Jamie was a graduate of Southeastern University in Lakeland Florida in 2010. Jamie and Lincoln met at Camp Gilead in 1999, when both were counselors. The next two summers, they served together as TEAM Leaders, Jamie has also served as a Territory Sales Coordinator, Business Manager, as well as Coordinator of Conference Services and Admission events for Southeastern University. Since 2011 Jamie has been Camp Gilead’s Registrar, and in 2012, was appointed as the Director of Development, working in areas of advertising, social networking, fundraising, and public relations.

Together, Lincoln and Jamie Simmons are a great team for the ministry of CBM as they lead the way **for such a time as this**. Let me share some of their goals for CBM.

- Desire to see the Tuckaleechee Retreat Center in Townsend, TN develop a ministry of their own as part of CBM.
- Desire that the ministry would move forward in a way that would be done with excellence, reflecting the awesomeness of our God.
- Desire to see the salvation of the unsaved, especially children, and to develop a ministry of discipleship to help these new believers grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord.
- Desire to minister to, encourage, and develop a greater unity among our missionary family in all 12 CBM areas.
- Desire to see the Lord lead CBM into new areas to share the Gospel.

I believe both Lincoln and Jamie come with a great level of enthusiasm for the CBM ministry as well as ministering to the needs of others. It is my prayer that God would protect and bless the lives of Lincoln and Jamie Simmons and that He would use them to direct the ministry of CBM. Also it is my prayer that they would see new doors of ministry opened to reach this generation for Christ. Please keep this couple in your prayers and let’s expect that God’s work will go forward in power and in the Spirit of the Lord.

- ◆ **CBM of North Alabama, Ponderosa Student Ministries** - Wow! We broke ground on November 14th for our first new staff house! \$25,000 has been raised and \$40,000 is needed to complete this project.
